Session 07

Team, Roles & Responsibilities and Expectations

A possible chemical management changed team structure is discussed in this session. The implementation of chemical management requires the establishment of an organisational structure (roles & responsibilities). It is important that a team is formed which will receive a clear mandate (terms of reference, job description) from the management.
